# BEFORE THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT OF SUSSEX COUNTY

#### IN RE: JOHN HUTSON

Case No. 19759 - 2011

A hearing was held after due notice on February 28, 2011. The Board members present were: Mr. Dale Callaway, Mr. Ronald McCabe, Mr. John Mills, Mr. Brent Workman and Mr. Jeff Hudson.

### Nature of the Proceedings

This is an application for a variance from the front yard setback requirement, for a through lot.

## Finding of Facts

The Board found that the Applicant was seeking a variance from front yard setback requirements for a through lot east of Road 285 (Beaver Dam Road), at the corner of Beaver Dam Road and Oak Crest Drive, Lot 112, Oak Crest Farms. The Applicant was requesting a 27' variance from the required 40' front yard setback for an existing shed. After a hearing, the Board made the following findings of fact:

- 1. The Applicant requested a building permit for an 8'x10' shed, but the zoning office listed incorrect setback requirements on the permit, apparently not recognizing the lot as a "through lot" with two from yard setbacks. The Applicant subsequently set the shed consistent with the permit.
- 2. An existing sunroom, underground wires, access panels to the dwelling, and HVAC units eliminate other possible locations for the shed.
- 3. The dwelling was originally a model home for the subdivision and has no garage. Hence, the shed is necessary for storage not otherwise present. In addition, there are numerous other sheds in the development.
- 4. The Board determined that the application generally met the standards for granting a variance.
- 5. No persons appeared in opposition.

The Board granted the requested variance.

#### Decision of the Board

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the application was granted. The Board members voting in favor were: Mr. Callaway, Mr. McCabe, Mr. Mills, Mr. Workman and Mr. Hudson; voting against – none.
