


FY2022 - Sources of Funds - \$975.8M


FY2022 - Uses of Funds - \$975.8M (in millions)


Henlopen TID Recommendations

Estimated Cost: \$4.6 million

- July 2021: Candidates are evaluated through Project Prioritization Process
- August 2021: Draft FY23 CTP released by Council on Transportation (COT)
- August September 2021: CTP Public Hearings
- October 2021: Public Comment Period Closes
- December 2021: COT Reviews Hearing Comments
- February 2022: COT Meeting to Adopt FY 23-28 CTP
