#### **RECOMMENDATIONS THAT:**


- 1. Implement smarter, sustainable development

- Q4 Focus: County Council prioritizes list of recommendations; begins public hearing process for Ordinances and/or Comprehensive Land Use Plan updates










## HOUSING, AFFORDABILITY & LAND USE CONDITIONS

## TOOLS & TECHNIQUES: WEIGHING BENEFITS AND DRAWBACKS

- A range of planning tools, zoning techniques, and funding mechanisms exist to guide land use, housing, and infrastructure decisions.
- Each approach comes with trade-offs—what works well in one part of the County may create challenges elsewhere.
- The impacts of policy choices are often experienced differently across communities, neighborhoods, and populations.
- Part of our work is to identify not only what could work, but also to understand who it works for—and at what cost.


