REVISED ASSESSMENT RATE
BLACKWATER VILLAGE AREA

Notice is hereby given that the Sussex County Council will hold a referendum on Thursday, June 6, 2024, between the hours of **5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.**, at Grace United Methodist Church, 300 E. Church Street, Millsboro, Delaware. The referendum will be for eligible voters whose property and/or residence is located within the Blackwater Village Area of the Sussex County Unified Sanitary Sewer District.

The questions on the ballot will be:

In Favor of Revised Assessment (\$1,815.00 per year)

Opposed to Revised Assessment (resulting in De-annexation from the unified sanitary sewer district)
