- 1. C/U #1926 –application of NANTICOKE SHORES ASSOCIATES, LLC an Ordinance to Amend Condition No. 8 of the Conditions of approval in Ordinance No. 2204 for Conditional Use No.1862 for Nanticoke Shore Associates, LLC as it relates to earthern berms around the perimeter of the property for a Campground/RV Park to be located on certain parcel of land lying and being in northeast of Long Neck Road (Road 22) 1 mile east of Pot Nets Road (Road 22C).
