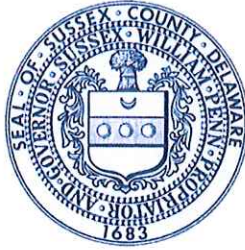

Subject Questions and Answers

NOTICE TO ALL PROSPECTIVE OFFERORS

The following questions and answers are hereby issued as Addendum No. 1 to the Request for Proposals for Type I & Type III Ambulances. The information contained herein shall be considered a part of the Contract Documents and shall be acknowledged with the proposal submission.

Question 1

Is County aware that the new DE NFPA Standard is 1900?

Answer

We were made aware after the RFP was posted. Unit shall meet the Delaware Fire Commission Requirement of NFPA-1900.

Question 2

Do we bid this as three (3) units or a single unit?

Answer

Submit pricing on a per-unit basis. The County shall purchase three (3) units per year, with the option to purchase additional units subject to funding availability. In addition, Sussex County ambulance companies that are not scheduled for a County ambulance allocation may also purchase units at the contract pricing established through this RFP.

Question 3

Should the bid be for a Type I ambulance, a Type III ambulance, or both?

Answer

Please provide a bid for each type of ambulance the vendor is able to provide.

Question 4

Do we bid the vehicle with the Power-LOAD® System or just the floor plate and pre-wire?

Answer

Bid the floor plate and pre-wire. Also provide, as a separate option, pricing for the complete Power-LOAD® System and installation.

Question 5

The alternate specification calls for electronic door locks on the module. Is this a separate switch, or do the electric door locks on the chassis cover this requirement?

Answer

Interface the chassis and module door locks with the remote lock switch located in the grille.

Question 6

Are air horns to be included?

Answer

No. If the end customer wants air horns, they may add them as an option at their own expense.

Question 7

Is the Plymovent exhaust adapter required to be included in the base bid or listed as an option? Currently, only one company (Millville) has the system.

Answer

Please list the Plymovent exhaust adapter as an option.

Question 8

The Type III chassis specifications generated several technical questions regarding GVWR, 4x4 capability, and available chassis options.

Answer

The Type III chassis specifications should be based on a chassis with a GVWR of approximately 14,500 pounds that is available from the manufacturer in a 4x2 configuration. A common industry reference is the Ford F-450 chassis. Other manufacturers may have discontinued or limited production of comparable chassis configurations.

Question 9

What are the required Type III body dimensions?
