

INVITATION TO BID

Sussex County will receive sealed bids **until 11:00 a.m. EDT, Wednesday, August 28, 2019**, in the Sussex County Administrative Office Building, 2 The Circle, Georgetown, Delaware 19947, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in Council Chambers for the following project:

THE OWL'S NEST PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS
Sussex County Project T20-01
Contract Term: 30 Consecutive Calendar Days

The project generally consists of all labor, materials, equipment and services required for installing a 2" hot-mix bituminous overlay on approximately 1,500 LF of existing subdivision streets, including but not limited to, pavement patching, maintenance of traffic, water and sewer casting adjustments, and site preparation and restoration necessary to complete the work.
