The Project consists of demolition of an existing package wastewater treatment plant, upgrade of an existing pump station, and extension of an existing sewage force main approximately 2,000 lineal feet. Also included is bypass pumping and miscellaneous site work.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form.
