

HOME REPAIR GRANT FUNDS

The Sussex County Council in cooperation with the Levy Court of Kent County, Delaware has received \$20,000 each in program funding from the United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, for the Housing Preservation Grant Program. These funds are available to repair owner occupied homes in the eligible areas of Kent County and Sussex County.

Funds are available to make housing repairs at no cost to eligible homeowners. The funds will be available on a first-come first served basis beginning **9:00 a.m.** on Monday, April 28, 2014.

Homeowners in need of repairs must contact the County where their property is located.
