Weekly Report to Council

1. Proposed Johnson's Corner Sanitary Sewer District

The Sussex County Engineering Department has postponed the public hearing previously scheduled to occur on Saturday, October 14, 2006, at 9:00 a.m. at the Roxana Fire Hall. The purpose of the meeting was to establish the boundaries of the proposed Johnson's Corner Sanitary Sewer District. The Sussex County Engineering Department is in the process of obtaining additional information concerning the engineering, design, boundaries, and construction requirements for the proposed district that will be presented during the hearing. As a result, the hearing will be postponed until that information becomes available, for the benefit of any interested parties.

2. <u>Beneficial Acceptance</u>

The Engineering Department granted Beneficial Acceptance on October 6, 2006, to Woods Cove, Agreement No. 381. The developer is Country Life Homes, and the project is located on County Road 275 in the West Rehoboth Expansion of the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer District, consisting of 185 multi-family dwellings. Included with this report is a fact sheet on the project.

3. Nor'easter Storm – October 6 and October 7

The Emergency Operations Center was activated on October 6 and October 7, 2006, for the nor'easter storm. Tide heights were over two feet above normal in some locations, especially in the Oak Orchard area. Some beach erosion was experienced. There was flooding of roadways and corridors in the Long Neck, Oak Orchard, Dewey Beach, and Bethany Beach areas. Damage to County sewer and water infrastructure was minimal. Intermittent power outages affect, and continue to affect, pump stations due to salt on power lines.

4. County Telephone System

The new County Administration Building telephone system went on line October 4, 2006. Overall the telephone system has worked well. Training was provided to each employee. The County Information Systems Department is handling problems and changes to the system.
