Paramedic Student Proposal Mr. Luedtke, Director of EMS, presented a Paramedic Student Proposal which is being proposed to increase the number of paramedics available to address normal attrition and planned growth within the County's service while increasing job opportunities for Sussex County residents. Beginning in March 2004, Sussex County EMS proposes to employ three individuals per year in the position of Paramedic Student. Students will receive a salary, benefits, uniforms, and supplies. Sussex County will also provide tuition and fees for these students. These costs will be shared by the Delaware Office of EMS on a 60/40 basis. In turn, each student will agree to serve a minimum of three years as a paramedic with Sussex County EMS, or will be required to reimburse the County for its portion of tuition and fees.

Applications will be taken from the public and students will be selected following an interview process that includes written, practical, and oral testing. They will also have to be Nationally Registered MET-Basics and meet the Delaware Technical and Community College criteria for entrance into the paralegal program.

Proposal (continued)

Mr. Luedtke reported that the cost of the proposal in Fiscal Year 2005 will be \$142,995.00, 40 percent of which will be reimbursed by the State. This amount will be included in the FY '05 budget proposal. Any expenditure needed in the current fiscal year for this project will be absorbed within the current EMS budget.

Oak Orchard SSD/ Change Order Mr. Izzo, County Engineer, discussed Change Order No. 1 to Contract 99-16A, Oak Orchard Sanitary Sewer District. Contract A was for the construction (by Hopkins Construction) of the force main from the sewer district out to the treatment plant. Mr. Izzo stated that he has a proposed balancing change order in the credit amount of \$61,562.02.

Engineering Services Agreement/ Plan Review Mr. Izzo presented a proposed Engineering Service Agreement with Cabe Associates, Inc. and a proposal for to establish a new fee schedule for plan reviews. Currently, plan reviews are performed by the Engineering Chapter under Chapter 99 for road construction and drainage in new subdivisions and residential planned communities. In addition, plan reviews are currently performed by the Engineering Department for sewer and water plans under Chapter 110, also known as Ordinance No. 38.

Mr. Izzo introduced two principals from the firm of Cabe Associates, Inc.

Mr. Izzo stated that the proposal is to look into subbing out some of the plan reviews that are currently being done in-house. He noted that due to a staff shortage and the volume of applications being received, the Engineering Department is having trouble keeping up with the workload.

Engineering Services Agreement/ Plan Review (continued) Mr. Izzo reported that proposals were solicited from Whitman, Requardt & Associates and Cabe Associates. He noted that the fees included in the proposal received from Whitman, Requardt & Associates were too high. Mr. Izzo distributed proposed fee schedules from Cabe Associates for subdivision plan reviews and sewer and water plan reviews.

It was noted that the County would still perform field inspections.

Councilmembers expressed concern that the proposed fee structure reflects substantial increases compared to the fees currently charged by the County. Mr. Dukes commented that he would like to receive some feedback on the proposed fee structure from developers and that he would like to defer action for several weeks.

Mr. Izzo stated that he believes there is a public benefit to charge the higher fee and to be able to provide a faster turn-around time.

Mr. Izzo stated that the purpose of the discussion today was to establish the concept of subbing out this work before the County actually enters into an agreement with Cabe Associates. He noted that, unless Council disagrees, he would continue to negotiate a contract with Cabe Associates for a possible implementation date sometime in January.

Mr. Stickels stated that he would work with Mr. Izzo and Mr. Green on sending proposed fee schedules to developers to obtain feedback.

SCRWF Effluent Filter and Pump Station 100 Project/ Contract Amendment Mr. Archut, Assistant County Engineer, discussed Contract Amendment No. 2 to Modification No. 4 to an Agreement with George, Miles and Buhr for the South Coastal Regional Wastewater Facility, Effluent Filter and Pump Station 100 Project. Mr. Archut advised that this is a proposed amendment to an Agreement with George, Miles & Buhr for Design, Contract Administration and Construction Administration work. Mr. Archut noted that both of these projects were completed in 2002 and during that time, the County has questioned invoices that exceeded the contract and the County has been in negotiations with George, Miles & Buhr. Mr. Archut reported that there were some changes in the scope of work on the filter and the pump station. The first increase they asked for was in the amount of \$42,000.00. Following the County's review of this increase, it was concluded that \$9,500.00 of that amount was unjustified. George, Miles

SCRWF Effluent Filter and Pump Station 100 Project/ & Buhr has finally agreed to this, thereby reducing the amount down to \$32,400.00. In addition, there was a small credit on one part of the contract in the amount of \$126.00. Lastly, both of the contracts went over on time because the contractors did not finish on time and in terms of liquidated damages, the County assessed this back on the contractors in the amount of \$1,260.00.

NEMO network programs are multi-agency coalitions that draw upon the expertise and resources of partner agencies and organizations within their states. One agency is needed to lead and organize the effort, often a role filled by University Cooperative Extension or Sea Grant Extension programs.

The intent of NEMO is to educate local land use decision makers about the links between land use and natural resource protection and to form a collaborative unit among those groups that are doing watershed and natural resource protection work.
