EPCRA Reporting Virtual Workshops

DNREC hosted four training workshops between December 2023 and February 2024 for reporting facilities. The workshops covered both the regulatory background and the online reporting software, with specific emphasis on Tier II Reports due March 1st. 184 people attended throughout the workshop series, and post-event surveys indicate that they were well received. Table 4. Missing Facility Status

- On March 4th, 2024, there were 108 facilities in the TierllManager[™] database that had not reported for RY 2023 (due 3/1/2024). DNREC is in contact with facilities to resolve missing/late reports, and an updated missing facility list will be provided in May's LEPC Meeting.
- On March 2nd, 2023, there were 127 facilities in the TierIIManager[™] database that had not reported for RY 2022 (due 3/1/2023). DNREC was able to contact and resolve most of these missing reports. The list of 25 facilities below was forwarded to LEPC's on May 18th, 2023, so LEPC's could determine if the facilities were still operating, and if so, find new contact information. The current status of missing Tier II report is shown in the last column.

DEMA Report for LEPC Meeting-March 2024

SERC Report

- At the February 15 Planning and Training Committee meeting there was a discussion regarding the Pipeline Emergency Responders Initiative (PERI). PHMSA's mission for PERI is to advance the abilities of emergency responders to manage pipeline emergencies through improved training, cooperation, and communication. There are likely to be ongoing discussions related to pipeline preparedness going forward.
- The Finance and Budget Committee is scheduled to meet on March 11 to review FY25 SERC budget applications and review a funding request for hazmat equipment storage fees.
- The next Planning and Training Committee meeting is on May 16.
- The next SERC meeting is on March 13. The following SERC meeting is June 12.

HMEP Report

- Currently in Year 2 of the HMEP three-year grant period. \$179,752.00 Total Grant Amount for Year 2. For Year 2 we have spent \$5,550.
- For Year 1, there was \$36,315.55 left unspent. \$10,100 of that was transferred to NCC LEPC for Year 2 projects. \$2,100 has been transferred to DEMA for Year 2 management costs. \$16,050 has been transferred to DSFS for a Year 2 project.
- The Year 3 HMEP Grant allocations were approved by the Planning and Training Committee. These allocations will be reviewed at the March 13 SERC meeting for approval. Continuing application due to PHMSA by April 1.
- Second Quarter reports will be requested from HMEP Subgrantees on April 1 with a return date of April 15.
