I spoke with Ms. Mackenzie Peet this morning regarding the above referenced project.

As I promised her, I am letting you know the outcome of our conversation.

At this time the owners are looking for approval to start the mini golf portion of the project. I advised Ms. Peet, they may start site work and prep the soils without any county permits.

Also, due to the proposed scope of work, the Building Code Office will not require any plan reviews or approval for just the mini golf course portion, but will require submittals for any future structures.

Therefore, Building Code does not have any objections to issuance of permits for installing foundations or forms just for the golf course, but will require all approvals before any zoning inspection approvals are granted.
