\*08/12/23: We moved into our new residence in Selbyville.

\*12/15/23: Sussex County Building Code issued me a permit to add a roof and screening onto the deck. We hired a local contractor to do the work.

\*05/21/24: The final inspection was scheduled. When I returned home from work that afternoon, a small, blue document was scotchtaped onto our frontdoor, indicating "Final 5-21-24" with the initials "SM" on it. I interpreted this to mean that we had passed the final inspection.

\*08/20/24: Dionne Baker, of Sussex County Building Code, called to inform us that our project had actually failed the final inspection. On the same day, Alan W. Shields, of Sussex County Building Code, stopped by at our residence to confer with us. We appreciated his perspective. On that very morning, I had retired after 48 years as an educator. My plan was to prepare for a knee replacement surgery by beginning the required pre-surgical physical therapy.

\*09/24: I exchanged some emails with Marina Truitt of Sussex County Planning and Zoning. She informed me of how to go about applying for a variance, which started with a required survey.

\*10/25/24: The survey was completed by Cotten Engineering.

\*12/03/24: My knee replacement surgery took place, and the post-surgery physical therapy began. This soon revealed that I also had three herniated discs in my lower back, which was causing severe sciatic pain.

\*02/10/25: I began chiropractic treatments to relieve the pain. To be honest, I wasn't thinking much last winter about a variance application.

\*06/04/24: I contacted the surveyor, paid the bill, and received a copy of the survey by way of email. \*We had received no contact from them to this point-no bill, no copy of the survey.

\*06/13/25: I was diagnosed with cancer. Surgery was scheduled for July 2.

\*06/29/25: While on vacation with my family, I received a tactful phone call from Dionne, informing me that I was about to receive a letter indicating that my roof project was being turned over to state authorities. She patiently listened to my whole story, and graciously told me to take six months for the surgery and recuperation.

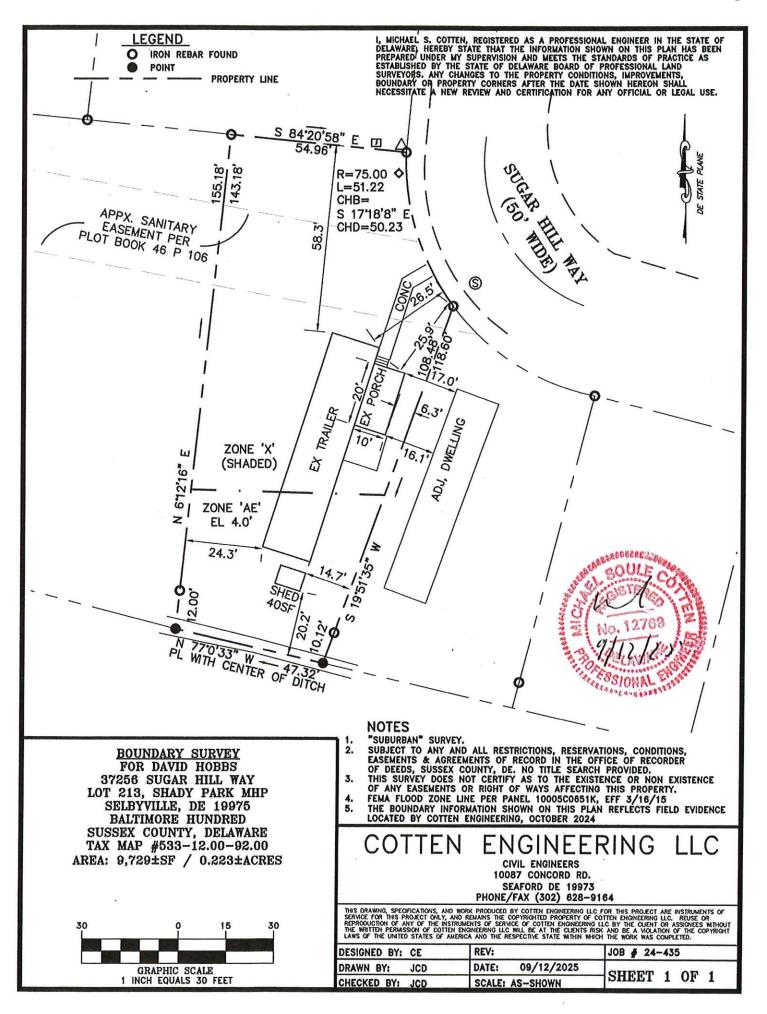

## FOOTING INSPECTION-

- · Prior to pouring concrete
- Minimum of 24" inches below finished grade
- Pole buildings must be a minimum 36" inches below grade
- · Re-bar and reinforcement tied and in place (when required)
- · Footings free of debris, organic material, and water
- · Concrete shall not be placed on frozen soil

\*Building Code automatically checks the building setbacks when we perform a footing inspection. However, in some cases, a third-party engineering company may perform a footing inspection. #### CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY-

Issued when the above documents are received, and Sussex County field inspections are completed. It may take up to 48 hours to
process. Please take this into consideration when scheduling your closings.

County approved plans must be kept on job site for inspectors' review to receive an inspection.

Additional inspections after 5 inspections (Except Modular Home Projects without site-built additions) shall be charged \$40.00 per trip and to be paid before the issuance of the certificate of occupancy. Modular Home projects will be charged \$40.00 per trip after 4 inspections.

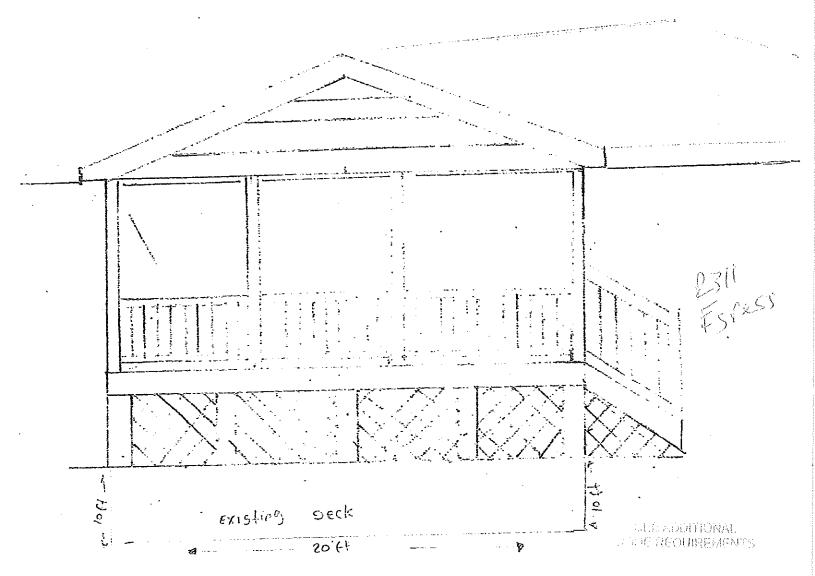

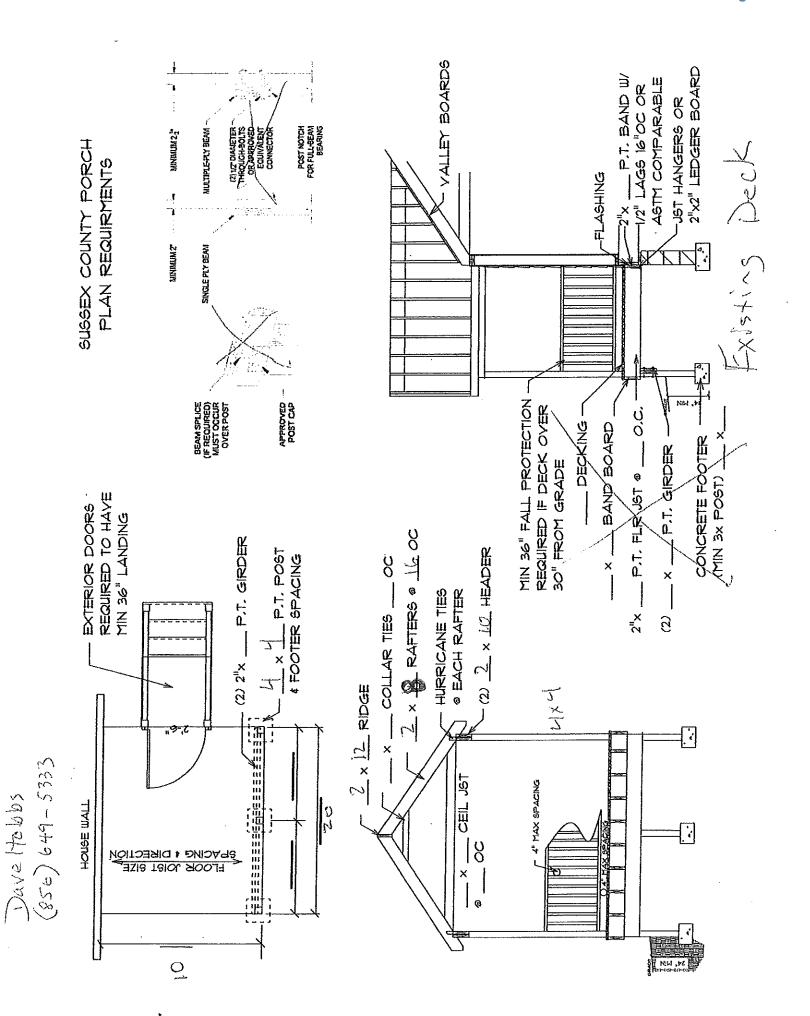

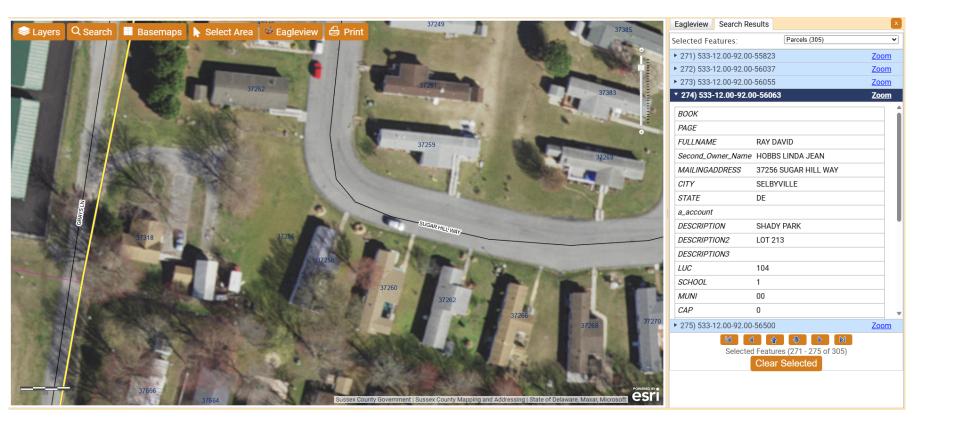

### Variance Application 29148 Green Street, Prime Hook

### Variances Requested

William and Frances Ziegler bought this property by deed dated June 3, 1965. According to the records of Sussex County, the existing home was built on the property in 1964 or 1965, prior to the enactment of the Sussex County setback ordinances related to this property. The Zieglers sold the property to the applicant, Judith Coleman, on July 29, 2025. A survey was done prior to the settlement and it was taken to Sussex County Planning and Zoning for review and approval. The County noted the following issues:

- 1. Because of the age of the home, it is a legal non-conforming structure. Since it is too close to the front property line using today's 30' setback, anything added to the front necessarily is also too close. The County has no record of when the Zieglers built the existing front deck/stairs but they were not part of the original home. Since the deck/stairs is 11.9' from the front property line and since the front setback is 30', a variance of 18.1' is required and is being sought.
- 2. The Zieglers obtained a permit in 1980 to build the garage but they built it too close to the side property line. Based on the size of the lot, the zoning classification, and the present setback requirements, it must be five feet from the side property line. It is 3.3' from that line so a variance of 1.7' is required and is being sought.

Therefore, the two variances being sought are: (1) a 18.1' front yard variance for the front deck with stairs, and (2) 1.7' side yard variance for the garage.

#### Uniqueness of the Property

1. One unique feature of this property is that the home on it is so old that it pre-dates the Sussex County ordinances relating to setbacks and it is in a section of Prime Hook Beach which has a number of older homes like this one, the majority of which are much closer to Green Street than the present 30' requirement. The aerial photo attached to this application shows that most of the homes, except for those which are obviously newer, are about as close to Green Street as the applicant's.

Another unique feature is that the applicant is not asking to be allowed to construct something in the setbacks or to expand the current encroachment, she is only asking that what has been there for many years be allowed to remain. Since the Zieglers never got a permit for the front deck/stairs, it is not certain when it was added. However, in 1985 the Zieglers did get a permit for the rear deck/stairs and the attached aerial photo shows that the front and back deck/stairs are very similar. Therefore, it is safe to assume that the existing front deck/stairs has been a part of this property for almost 40 years.

The garage was built in 1980, 45 years ago, and that it has been in its present location that long. The lot is narrow and the garage is large. The Zieglers, who are very elderly, could not explain why the garage was built 1.7' closer than it should have been and they were not aware of this encroachment until the settlement. This is certainly not an encroachment that can be corrected. They confirmed that its present location has never been a concern to adjacent property owners. Also, they said that the septic system installed on the property in the 1960's was in the back left corner of the property, so possibly that is why the garage was built where it is. They did just install a new septic system and it takes up almost all of the back yard, right up to the garage.

[The shed which is shown on some of the aerial photos is no longer there because it had to be removed to install the new septic system.]

#### 2. Cannot otherwise be developed:

The existing garage possibly could have been built 5' from the side property line 45 years ago and, as noted, the Zieglers were not sure why it wasn't other than because of the septic system. However, it has been in its present location since it was built in 1980 and it has had no negative impact on other properties. The applicant would suffer a massive exceptional practical difficulty and hardship if the garage had to be removed because the variance was denied.

When the home was built in 1964/1965, there was a deck or landing with stairs to allow access through the front door. As noted above, since the home itself is less than 30' from the front property line, any replacement deck/stairs had to be built less than 30' from the front property line also so there is no reason not to approve this variance.

#### 3. Not created by the applicant:

The existing home was built almost 60 years ago, the garage was built about 45 years ago, and the front deck/stairs was built about 40 years ago. The applicant has owned the property for less than two months, so she obviously did not create the exceptional practical difficulties. The home is compatible with other older homes in the area as to its proximity to Green Street and as to the age, size, and location of outbuildings. Since the front door is less than 30' from the front property line, any front deck/stairs will be less than 30' from the front property line. From a practical and financial standpoint, the side setback encroachment cannot be corrected without removing the garage.

### 4. Will not alter the essential character of the neighborhood:

Since the existing home with the attached front deck/stairs and the detached garage have existed and been used in their present locations without any negative impact on surrounding properties or the neighborhood for 40-60 years, it is not reasonable to conclude that allowing everything to stay where they are will suddenly substantially or permanently impair the appropriate use or development of adjacent properties or be detrimental in any way to the public good.

#### 5. Minimum variance:

The applicant is not seeking to increase the existing encroachments; the applicant just wants to leave the home, the front deck/stairs, and the garage where they have been for so many years. The age of the property requires that the variances be granted so the applicant may continue to use the property as the Zieglers used it for the past 60 years. If the variance for the front deck/stairs were denied, it would have to be removed and there would be no access via the front door. If the variance for the garage were to be denied, the only remediation available would be to remove the garage entirely. The purpose of variances is to prevent the applicant from suffering the extreme exceptional practical difficulties and hardship that would ensue if her application for the two variances were to be denied.
