

RESOLUTION NO. R 028 09

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE DATE, TIME, AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD TO CONSIDER THE REQUEST TO EXTEND THE LOCHWOOD STREETLIGHTING DISTRICT BOUNDARY AND TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL STREETLIGHTING

WHEREAS, Chapter 95 of the Sussex County Code provides for the establishment, maintenance, and modification of a streetlighting district; and

WHEREAS, Sussex County currently operates Lochwood Streetlighting District; and

WHEREAS, 37 signed and notarized petitions were received from Lochwood improvement owners requesting Sussex County Council to extend the boundary of the existing Streetlighting District to include all parcels in the Lochwood subdivision, as shown on Sussex County Tax Map 2-34-11- Parcels 118 - 419; and to install additional streetlights; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the annual billing rate for the installation of 20 additional streetlights and the relocation of one existing streetlight is estimated to be \$ 33.83 for the first year and \$ 23.97 after the first year, for each property having a residential or commercial improvement located within the boundaries of Lochwood Streetlighting District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council does establish Tuesday, January 12, 2010, at 11:00 a.m., at the Sussex County Council Chambers in the Sussex County Administrative Office Building, 2 The Circle, Georgetown, Delaware, as the date, time, and place for the public hearing to consider the requests made for Lochwood Streetlighting District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a final decision on the requests will be made by the Sussex County Council immediately following the public hearing on January 12, 2010 ; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sussex County Engineering Department is directed to provide appropriate notice to all owners within the Lochwood subdivision, of the date, time, and place of the public hearing, and the estimated costs and charges for the installation of 20 additional streetlights and the relocation of one existing streetlight, as required by Chapter 95 of the Sussex County Code.
