A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARY OF THE DAGSBORO-FRANKFORD SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT (DFSSD) TO INCLUDE THE LANDS OF DAGSBORO PROPERTIES, LLC, SITUATE, LYING WEST OF MAIN STREET AND BEING IN DAGSBORO HUNDRED, SUSSEX COUNTY, DELAWARE

WHEREAS, Sussex County has established the Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary
Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, in the best interests of the present district, and to enhance the general health and welfare of that portion of Sussex County north of the Town of Frankford, which includes the lands of Dagsboro Properties, LLC, which are contiguous to the DFSSD, the inclusion of this property will be beneficial; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del.C.</u>, Section 6502 (a), the Sussex County Council may, upon request of the County Engineer, revise the boundary of an established sewer district when 50 or more houses have been connected by posting a public notice in four public places in the district describing the new or revised boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council has caused to be posted a public notice in at least four public places in the district, as verified by the affidavit of Rob Davis and Lora Hudson, a copy of which affidavit and public notice is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del.C.</u>, Section 6502 (b), the Sussex County Council shall, within thirty days after posting the public notices pass a formal Resolution establishing the new boundary of the district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council hereby revises the boundary of the Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District to encompass the lands of Dagsboro Properties, LLC, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point, said point being on the DFSSD boundary, said point also being the westernmost property corner of lands now or formerly of (N/F) Ebe H. Chandler heirs, said point further being 773 feet more or less southwest of the right-of-way (ROW) of County Road 401, said point also being a property corner of lands N/F William S. and Marlene Y. D'Angelo; thence proceeding by and with said D'Angelo lands in a southwesterly direction a distance of 648 feet more or less to a point, said point being on the centerline of Pepper Creek Canal; thence leaving said D'Angelo lands and proceeding by

and with said Pepper Creek Canal in a northerly direction a distance of 1,375 feet more or less to a point, said point being the southwesternmost property corner of lands N/F Helen I. Turner; thence leaving said centerline and proceeding by and with said Turner lands in a northeasterly direction a distance of 520 feet more or less to a point; said point being on the DFSSD boundary; thence leaving said Turner lands and proceeding by and with said DFSSD boundary in a southerly direction a distance of 1,325 feet more or less to the point and place of BEGINNING.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council directs the County Engineer and the Attorney for the County Council to procure the necessary lands and right-of-way by purchase, agreement, or condemnation in accordance with the existing statutes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer is hereby directed to prepare maps, plans, specifications, and estimates, elect contracts for and supervise the construction and maintenance of, or enlarging and remodeling of, any and all structures required to provide for the safe disposal of sewage in the sanitary sewer district, as amended.

PROPOSED EXPANSION TO THE DAGSBORO-FRANKFORD SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sussex County Council voted on October 24, 2006 to consider extending the Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District (DFSSD) to include the lands of Dagsboro Properties, LLC, situate, lying west of Main Street, and being in Dagsboro Hundred, Sussex County, Delaware.

This action is in conformity with 9 Del.C. §6502.

A description of the area, which is contiguous to and to be added to the DFSSD is described as follows:

Beginning at a point, said point being on the DFSSD boundary, said point also being the westernmost property corner of lands now or formerly (N/F) Ebe H. Chandler heirs, said point further being 773 feet more or less southwest of the right-of-way (ROW) of County Road 401, said point also being a property corner of lands N/F William S. & Marlene Y. D'Angelo; thence proceeding by and with said D'Angelo lands in a southwesterly direction a distance of 648 feet more or less to a point, said point being on the centerline of Pepper Creek Canal; thence leaving said D'Angelo lands and proceeding by and with said Pepper Creek Canal in a northerly direction a distance of 1375 feet more or less to a point, said point being the southwesternmost property corner of lands N/F Helen I. Turner; thence leaving said centerline and proceeding by and with said Turner lands in a northeasterly direction a distance of 520 feet more or less to a point, said point being on the DFSSD boundary; thence leaving said Turner lands and proceeding by and with said DFSSD boundary in a southerly direction a distance of 1325 feet more or less to the point and place of BEGINNING.

The proposed expansion of the DFSSD is within these boundaries. The boundary description has been prepared using Sussex County Tax Map No. 2-33-11:00, 2-33-16.00 and a deed provided by Kercher Engineering, Inc. and found in Deed Book 2261 Page 219 in the Sussex County Recorder of Deeds office.

A map outlining and describing the expansion of the DFSSD is attached. The area involved is crosshatched.

The public hearing will be held on this issue at 11:00 A.M. on December 5, 2006 in the Sussex County Council Chambers, County Administrative Offices, 2 The Circle, Georgetown, Delaware. All interested persons, officials, residents, voters, taxpayers, property owners, or corporations in any way affected by this boundary expansion are welcome to attend. There will be an opportunity for questions and answers. The final decision on the boundary expansion will be made by the Sussex County Council following the hearing, at one of their regularly scheduled meetings.
