## RESOLUTION NO. 007 74

WHEREAS, a petition was received July 20, 1971 from electors of the Town of Blades requesting Sussex County Council to submit the question of organizing a sanitary sewer district to a vote of electors residing in that area; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on March 7, 1974 on the question of organizing a sanitary sewer district dealing with the location of the boundaries of the Town of Blades; and

WHEREAS, Sussex County Council determined there were no valid reasons for altering the boundaries of the District as petitioned;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by Sussex County Council:

That the establishment of a sanitary sewer district is in the best interests of the Town of Blades;

That the boundaries of the proposed sanitary sewer district will be those established as all lands within the Town limits as surveyed by Matz, Childs and Associates dated December 7, 1973;

That in consideration of the Public Hearing being favorable; a referendum will be held on April 27, 1974 at the Blades Town Hall between the hours of 1:00 P. M. and 5:00 P. M. E.D.T. for the establishment of a sanitary sewer district within the Town Limits of Blades.
