RECOGNIZING 1991 AS COUNTY SEAT BICENTENNIAL YEAR

WHEREAS, the Delaware House of Assembly on January 29, 1791, responding to the expressed wishes of a majority of the citizens of Sussex County, did enact legislation calling for the removal of the seat of county government from Lewes to a "more central location"; and

WHEREAS, this year marks the 200th Anniversary of the establishment of Georgetown as the home of Sussex County Government; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown, the Georgetown 200 Committee, and various groups and community organizations have planned a yearlong celebration to commemorate this important event;
