A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARY OF THE FENWICK ISLAND SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT TO ENCOMPASS A CONTIGUOUS AREA OF .98 ACRES MORE OR LESS, APPROXIMATELY 916 FEET EAST OF THE CENTERLINE OF RIVER RUN ROAD, THE ENTRANCE-WAY TO KEENWICK SOUND, PHASE I.

WHEREAS, Sussex County has established the Fenwick Island Sanitary Sewer District;

WHEREAS, a letter dated November 12, 1992, was received by the Sussex County Council from Marvin Long requesting his property, being .98 acres more or less, be included in the sanitary sewer district;

WHEREAS, in the best interests of the present district, and to enhance the general health and welfare of that portion of Sussex County west of Fenwick Island, the inclusion of the property near the Keenwick Sound subdivision would be beneficial;

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del.C.</u>, Section 6502 (a), the Sussex County Council may, upon request of the County Engineer, revise the boundary of an established sewer district when 50 or more houses have been connected by posting a public notice in four public places in the district describing the new or revised boundary;

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council has caused to be posted a public notice in at least four public places in the district, as verified by the affidavit of Anthony DiGiuseppe, a copy of which affidavit and public notice is attached hereto and made a part hereof;

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del.C.</u>, Section 6502 (b), the Sussex County Council shall, within thirty days after posting the public notices pass a formal resolution establishing the new boundary of the district,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED the Sussex County Council hereby revises the boundary of the Fenwick Island Sanitary Sewer District to encompass the property near the Keenwick Sound subdivision as follows:

BEGINNING at a 3/4 inch iron pipe on the southerly right-of-way (ROW) of State of Delaware Route 54, said point being the northwesternmost property corner of land now or formerly (N/F) of Herbert L. and Lois V. Chapman, said point also being the northeastern property corner of land N/F of Marvin Long; thence proceeding by and with the southern ROW of Route 54 (1) North $86^{\circ}39'58"$ west, 150 feet to a point being on the boundary line of the Fenwick Island Sanitary Sewer District; thence proceeding with the boundary line (2) south $05^{\circ}48'04"$ west, 274.30feet to a point where it meets the lands of the Keenwick Sound subdivision; thence proceeding (3) south $80^{\circ}04'49"$ east, 150 feet to a 3/4" iron pipe, thence proceeding by and with other lands N/F of Marvin Long (4) north $05^{\circ}1'00"$ east, 291.53 feet to the point of beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council directs the County Engineer and the Attorney for the County Council to procure the necessary lands and right-of-way by purchase, agreement, or condemnation in accordance with the existing statutes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer is hereby directed to prepare maps, plans, specifications, and estimates, elect contracts for and supervise the construction and maintenance of, or enlarging and remodeling of, any and all structures required to provide for the safe disposal of sewage in the sanitary sewer district, as amended.

The above described parcel of land contains .98 acres be the same more or less.


A map outlining and describing the extension of the Fenwick Island Sanitary Sewer District is attached. The area involved is cross-hatched.
