CHANGING THE NAME OF STATE ROAD NO. 283, APPROXIMATELY TWO MILES SOUTH OF THE TOWN OF LEWES, DELAWARE BORDERING SANDY BRAE DEVELOPMENT TO THE NORTH AND FARM LANDS TO THE SOUTH, FROM "ANGLIN ROAD" TO "POSTAL LANE"

WHEREAS, a letter has been received from Samuel C. Warrington II with a copy of a petition, with fifteen signatures, to the U. S. Post Office, Lewes, Delaware requesting the name of State Road No. 283, approximately two miles south of the Town of Lewes, Delaware bordering Sandy Brae Development to the north and farm lands to the south, be changed from "Anglin Road" to "Postal Lane"; and

WHEREAS, this road has never officially had a name but was believed to be known at one time as "Postal Lane" but recently residents have been receiving mail with the address being changed to "Anglin Road"; and

WHEREAS, residents desire that this road be known as "Postal Lane" as it was once believed to be known,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Sussex County Council that the name of State Road No. 283, approximately two miles south of the Town of Lewes, Delaware, bordering Sandy Brae Development to the north and farm lands to the south, be changed from "Anglin Road" to "Postal Lane" as requested by residents on the road; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be sent to the Postmaster of Lewes, Delaware; Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, State of Delaware; Troop 4, Delaware State Police; the Planning and Zoning Commission of Sussex County, Delaware; and the Emergency Operations Center of Sussex County, Delaware.
