

RESOLUTION NO. R 010 90

PROVIDING FOR FEES FOR HOLDING TANK PERMITS ISSUED IN THE SOUTH COASTAL PLANNING AREA TO BE TREATED AT THE SOUTH COASTAL REGIONAL WASTEWATER FACILITIES

WHEREAS, on October 29, 1985, the Sussex County Council agreed that permanent holding tank letters would be issued for property located within the South Coastal Planning Area that has been recorded on or before April 8, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the issuing of permanent holding tank letters involves administrative expense and obligates wastewater treatment capacity to the letter holder; and

WHEREAS, the South Coastal Area Planning Study recommends that a "holding tank fee" be established which would be levied to property owners and/or developers for authorization by Sussex County to accept holding tank wastes at the South Coastal Regional Wastewater Facilities; and

WHEREAS, holding tank fees have been previously established by the Sussex County Council for the State of Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control's designated septic system moratorium area along the Route 1 corridor south of Five Points and north of the the Lewes-Rehoboth Canal; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 1984, the Sussex County Council established reasonable charges for treating holding tank wastewater at the South Coastal Regional Wastewater Facilities of a \$30.00 minimum charge per vehicle with a two cents (\$.02) additional charge for each gallon over 1,500 gallons during normal working hours and a \$45.00 minimum charge per vehicle with each additional gallon over 1,500 gallons at three cents (\$.03) per gallon during Saturdays, Sundays or holidays;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council has determined it is in the best interest of the public health to continue accepting permanent holding tank wastewater as outlined in the

October 29, 1985 motion at the South Coastal Regional Wastewater Facilities from properties in the South Coastal Planning Area as defined in the South Coastal Area Planning Study; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this process will be continued until central wastewater systems are constructed and operational in the South Coastal area; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED each property owner wishing to discharge to the South Coastal Regional Wastewater Facilities will pay the holding tank treatment fees as given above and a one time permit fee according to the following schedule:

First EDU*	\$500.00
Additional EDUs:	
0.0 to 4.00	\$250.00 per EDU
4.01 to 9.00	\$200.00 per EDU
9.01 to 14.00	\$150.00 per EDU
14.01 and above.	\$100.00 per EDU

*EDU means Equivalent Dwelling Unit

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that wastewater haulers wishing to discharge temporary holding tank wastewater at the South Coastal Regional Wastewater Facilities from properties in the South Coastal Planning Area will pay an annual fee of \$100.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution will take effect immediately upon its adoption.

First EDU =	\$ 500.00
Three additional EDUs @ \$250.00 each =	750.00

EXAMPLE NO. 3

186 Seat Restaurant (10.55 EDUs)

First EDU =	\$ 500.00
Four additional EDUs @ \$250.00 each	1,000.00
Five additional EDUs @ \$200.00 each	1,000.00
.55 additional EDUs @ \$150.00	82.50
	<u>\$2,582.50</u>

EXAMPLE NO. 4

Sixty (60) room motel (20.0 EDUs)

First EDU =	\$ 500.00
Four additional EDUs @ \$250.00 each	1,000.00
Five additional EDUs @ \$200.00 each	1,000.00
Five additional EDUs @ \$150.00 each	750.00
Five additional EDUs @ \$100.00 each	500.00
	<u>\$3,750.00</u>

NOTE: EDU means Equivalent Dwelling Unit.
