

RESOLUTION NO. R 013 87

NO NEW TEMPORARY SANITARY SEWAGE HOLDING TANKS IN THE DEWEY BEACH
SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, developers, builders, realtors and private property owners in the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer District have known for sometime of the limited capacity of the Rehoboth Beach Sewage Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, temporary sanitary sewage holding tanks cause odors, health hazards and traffic congestion during pump-outs; and

WHEREAS, it has been public knowledge that the improvements to the Rehoboth Beach Treatment Plant would not be complete until mid-summer 1987 at the earliest; and

WHEREAS, in sewer construction projects of this scope construction delays are expected; and

WHEREAS, any residential construction projects in the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer District projecting completion for the 1987 summer season have only been gambling upon completion of the Rehoboth Beach Sewage Treatment Plant for the 1987 summer season,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Sussex County Council that no new connections will be allowed into the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer System until the Rehoboth Beach Sewage Treatment Plant is certified by the State Division of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC) as being operational; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Sussex County Council that no new temporary sewage holding tanks will be authorized for use in the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer District.
