RESOLUTION NO. R 015 92

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO APPRISE HANDICAPPED MOTORISTS OF A LAW INDICATING THEY ARE ENTITLED TO HAVE GASOLINE PUMPED FOR THEM AT SELF-SERVICE PRICES BY REQUIRING SERVICE STATIONS IN DELAWARE TO POST CONSPICUOUS SIGNS INDICATING SAME

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Chapter 29, § 2912, Title 6, <u>Delaware Code</u>, handicapped motorists are entitled to have gasoline pumped for them at self-service prices upon proper identification presented to the attendant, if so requested; and

WHEREAS, this provision became law during the 134th General Assembly on June 28, 1988; and

WHEREAS, a number of handicapped motorists, both in-state and out-of-state, are unaware of this statute; however, if conspicuous signs were posted at such stations who qualify under this statute, it is felt that many of our handicapped motorists would take advantage of this money saving provision;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council, having met in public session, encourages the Secretary of Public Safety and the Secretary of the Department of Transportation to develop a method of apprising handicapped motorists that they are entitled to have gasoline pumped for them at self-service prices; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution will be presented to the Secretary of Public Safety, Mr. Patrick W. Murray, and the Acting Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Mr. Mark A. McNulty.
