

RESOLUTION NO. R 015 93

ADOPTING THE EPA 201 WASTEWATER FACILITIES PLAN AND AMENDMENT NO. 1 FOR THE WEST REHOBOTH EXPANSION OF THE DEWEY BEACH SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT AS PROPOSED BY GEORGE, MILES & BUHR

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council established the West Rehoboth Expansion of the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer District by Resolution No. R 013 90 on March 22, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council entered into an agreement with George, Miles & Buhr on June 26, 1990, to prepare the EPA 201 Wastewater Facilities Plan for the West Rehoboth Expansion of the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, George, Miles & Buhr completed the West Rehoboth Expansion of the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer District Wastewater Facility Plan in July of 1991 and Amendment No. 1 in May of 1993 and recommended the following wastewater collection, conveyance, treatment and disposal facilities as the preferred plan:

- a combination gravity-pressure collection system with grinder pumps and gravity sewers; and
- a central conveyance system using a series of interceptors, pumping stations, and force mains along the major roads, to transport wastewater to the treatment and disposal site; and
- an aerated lagoon pre-treatment system at the preferred site near the northern end of County Road Number 270; and
- a spray irrigation land application facility for final treatment and disposal at the preferred site near the northern end of County Road Number 270.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sussex County Council, on behalf of the West Rehoboth Expansion of the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer District, adopts the West Rehoboth Expansion of the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer District Wastewater Facilities Plan Report as amended and dated May, 1993, as proposed.
