

RESOLUTION NO. R 016 04

TO SUBMIT A LONG-RANGE WASTEWATER FACILITIES PLANNING GRANT TO THE WASTEWATER FACILITIES ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR MATCHING FUNDS TO FINANCE A PLANNING STUDY FOR THE FENWICK ISLAND SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT STATE ROUTE 54 TRANSMISSION SYSTEM UPGRADE

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council adopted the South Coastal Area Planning Study on February 19, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Study stated that sections of State of Delaware Route 54 interceptor sewer could become overloaded if contributing areas were developed; and

WHEREAS, there has been strong growth in the Fenwick Island Sanitary Sewer District since that date; and

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council approved Amendment No. 25 to their current Agreement with Whitman, Requardt and Associates, L.L.P. on March 30, 2004, in the amount of \$51,690 to perform the planning study; and

WHEREAS, the Wastewater Facilities Advisory Council offers grants to assist in financing wastewater facility plans that recognize and are consistent with the County's Comprehensive Plan and the goals of Shaping Delaware's Future;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council of Sussex County, Delaware hereby approves the submittal of a Long-Range Wastewater Facility planning grant application to the Wastewater Facilities Advisory Council for up to \$20,000 in matching funds to assist in financing a planning study for the Fenwick Island Sanitary Sewer District State Route 54 Transmission System Upgrade.
