

RESOLUTION NO. R 016 79

TO ENDORSE GOVERNOR DU PONT'S REQUEST FOR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE  
FROM THE FEDERAL DISASTER ASSISTANCE ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, Sussex County has suffered a severe economic hardship as a result of the Storm of February 19, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council and Pierre S. du Pont IV, Governor of the State of Delaware, declared a State of Emergency for Sussex County that began on Monday, February 19, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the Agricultural Industry and many small businesses have been adversely affected by the Storm of February 19, 1979,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council endorses the Governor's request that the Federal Government, through the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration, provide financial assistance throughout Sussex County; and

Biden, Jr., United States Senator; The Honorable William V. Roth, Jr., United States Senator; The Honorable Thomas B. Evans, Jr., United States Representative; Mr. Bardyl Tirana, Director, Defense Civil Preparedness Agency; and The Honorable Pierre S. du Pont IV, Governor of the State of Delaware.
