

RESOLUTION NO. R 019 88

DISTRICT BOUNDARIES FOR THE PROPOSED DAGSBORO-FRANKFORD SEWER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, petitions were received on July 21, 1988 from fifty-three (53) legal voters of the proposed Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District requesting the Sussex County Council to submit the question of organizing a sanitary sewer district to a vote of electors residing in that area; a map of the proposed district boundaries is attached as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on August 23, 1988 on the question of organizing a sanitary sewer district dealing with the location of the boundaries of the proposed Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District as shown in Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, the County has proposed an estimate of \$348.00 per year for sanitary sewer service (installation, operations and maintenance) for the average size lot (100 front feet) with a single family residence based on cost estimates (which have been calculated to include \$6.4 million in State and Federal funds) provided by the consulting firm of George, Miles and Buhr of Salisbury, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, Sussex County Council has determined there are no valid reasons for altering the boundaries of the district;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Sussex County Council that the annual fee for capitalization of construction, operations and maintenance of \$348.00 is hereby estimated and projected for the first year of operation for referendum purposes for sanitary sewer service user costs for the Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the establishment of sanitary sewer district is deemed to be in the public interest and will be conducive to the preservation of the public health; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area described in Exhibit "A" is hereby established as the "Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District" and is more fully described as follows: encompassing the Towns of Dagsboro and Frankford and the Frankford Elementary School; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by majority vote of all members of the County Council of Sussex County, Delaware.

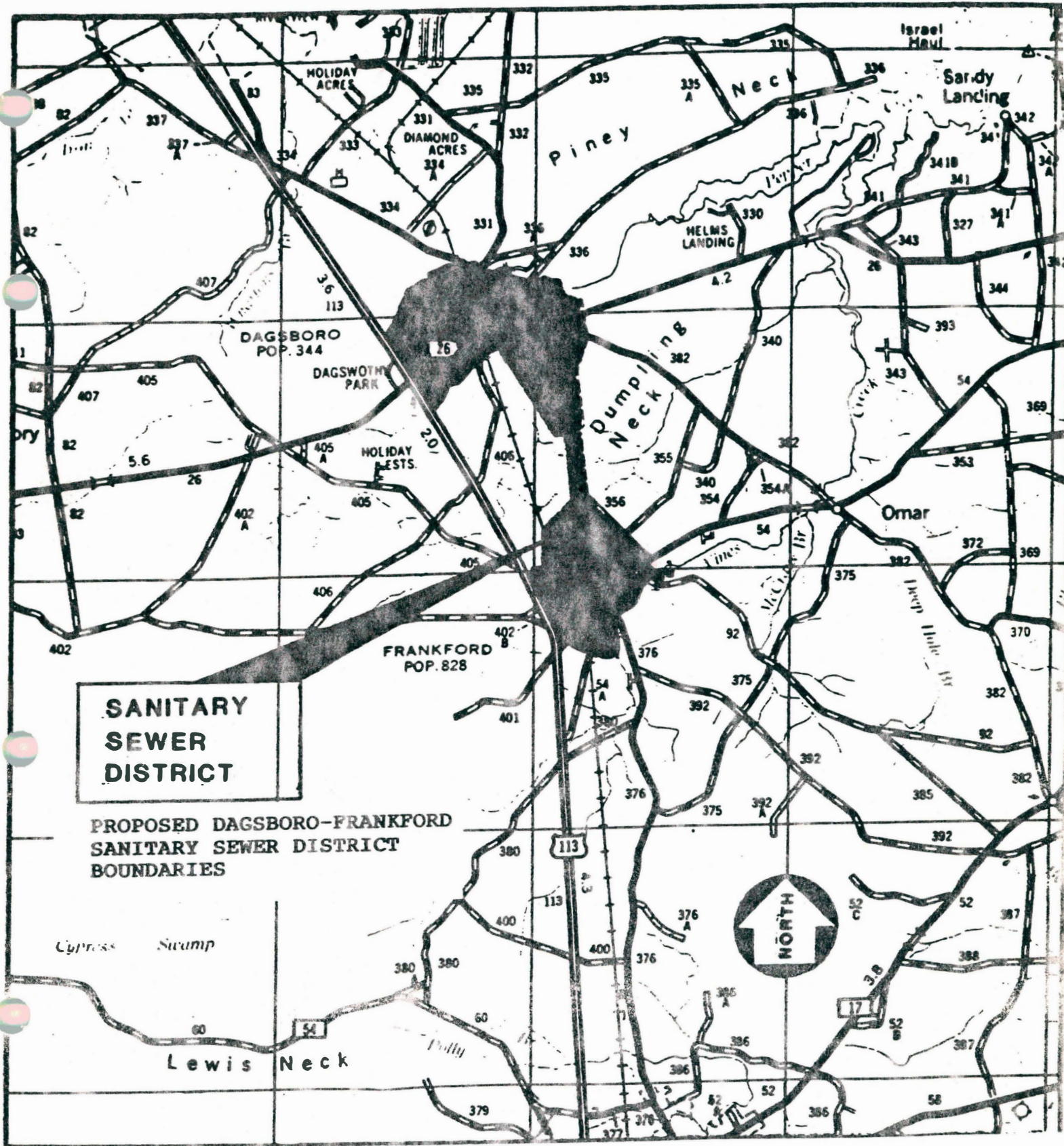

NOTICE OF  
PUBLIC HEARING

PROPOSED DAGSBORO-FRANKFORD SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sussex County Council will hold a public hearing on the question of organizing a sewer district for the proposed Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District. The proposed Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District encompasses the Towns of Dagsboro and Frankford and the Frankford Elementary School.

The proposed Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District is within these approximate boundaries. A map drawn to scale indicating the boundaries of the proposed sanitary sewer district accompanies this notice.

The public hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, August 23, 1988 at 7:00 p.m. at the Indian River High School, Dagsboro, Delaware.

All interested persons, officials, residents, voters, taxpayers, property owners or other persons or corporations in any way affected by the establishment of this district or wishing to be included in this district shall be heard on any question dealing with the boundaries of the district.
