

RESOLUTION NO. R 019 92

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DELAWARE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION TO UPGRADE U. S. ROUTE 113 FROM MILFORD TO
GEORGETOWN AS SOON AS POSSIBLE

WHEREAS, U. S. Route 113 from Milford to Georgetown is,
has been, and will be a continuing hazard to all persons who
travel upon it; and

WHEREAS, plans for the expansion, widening, and
improvement of U. S. Route 113 have been developed by the
Delaware Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, because of various delays, U. S. Route 113 has
not been expanded or improved and, as a result thereof, lives
have been unnecessarily lost because of the hazardous and
unsafe condition of U. S. Route 113; and

WHEREAS, because U. S. Route 113 continues to be one of
the three principal arterial corridors of Sussex County,
Delaware, but is unable to handle the traffic volume which
passes over it, thereby creating a public health and safety
hazard;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Sussex County
that the Department of Transportation and Mark A. McNulty,
Acting Secretary, are hereby encouraged to act with
expedition to construct the improvements necessary to make
U. S. Route 113 a safe highway in Sussex County before
further loss of life occurs.
