WHEREAS, by virtue of the provisions of Senate Bill 702 adopted June 25, 1971, granting homerule to Sussex County, the authority for the adoption of pay plans and procedures was vested exclusively with and in the County Council of Sussex County; and

WHEREAS, upon the advice of the Director of the Department of Finance it has been suggested that a more equitable and efficient method of payment of salaries and wages would be on a basis of 24 installments per year, rather than the payment of 12 installments a year as heretofore has been the case; and

WHEREAS, it has been further recommended by the said Director of Finance that the commencement of such installment payments on a 24 installment basis be implemented and adopted beginning with the pay period of July 1, 1971,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that commencing July 1, 1971, the payment of salaries and wages to Clerks and Employees of the County Council of Sussex County, in its regular divisions, department of Offices be and it hereby is changed to a 24 installment plan, the same to commence with the pay period of July 1, 1971; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the administration an implementation of the new pay system be through the facilities of the Farmers Bank of the State of Delaware upon such administrative basis as shall be established between said bank and the Director of the Department of Finance.
