A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARY OF THE LONG NECK SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT (LNSSD) TO INCLUDE PARCELS OF LAND AT THE INTERSECTION OF COUNTY ROADS 298 AND 299, BEING IN INDIAN RIVER HUNDRED, SUSSEX COUNTY, DELAWARE

WHEREAS, Sussex County has established the Long Neck Sanitary Sewer District (LNSSD); and

WHEREAS, in the best interests of the present district and to enhance the general health and welfare of that portion of Sussex County southwest of the LNSSD, the inclusion of this property will be beneficial; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del.C.</u>, Section 6502 (a), the Sussex County Council may, upon request of the County Engineer, revise the boundary of an established sewer district when 50 or more houses have been connected by posting a public notice in four public places in the district describing the new or revised boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council has caused to be posted a public notice in at least four public places in the district, as verified by the affidavit of Rob Davis and Penny Massey, a copy of which affidavit and public notice is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del.C.</u>, Section 6502 (b), the Sussex County Council shall, within thirty days after posting the public notices pass a formal resolution establishing the new boundary of the district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Sussex County Council hereby revises the boundary of the LNSSD to include parcels of land at the intersection of County Roads 298 and 299, as follows:

BEGINNING at a concrete monument situate along the northerly right of way of County Road 299 at a point marking a common boundary between the herein described lands and the adjoining Lot 54 of the Elisha A. Steele Subdivision, thence by and with the common boundary of Lot 54 North 18 degrees 01 minutes 45 seconds East by and with the boundary of Lot 79 in the Elisha A. Steele Subdivision a distance of 221.15 feet

to an iron pipe, said iron pipe also being on the boundary of the LNSSD; thence with said boundary South 41 degrees 55 minutes 15 seconds East 217.80 feet to an iron pipe set along the Northwesterly right of way of County Road 298; thence following said right of way and continuing with the boundary of the LNSSD, South 49 degrees 35 minutes 00 seconds West 130.95 feet to an iron pipe situated at the intersection of County Road 299; thence leaving the boundary of the LNSSD and continuing with the right of way of Road 299 North 72 degrees 12 minutes 25 seconds West 120 feet to the point of beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council directs the County Engineer and the Attorney for the County Council to procure the necessary lands and right-of-way by purchase, agreement, or condemnation in accordance with the existing statutes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer is hereby directed to prepare maps, plans, specifications, and estimates, elect contracts for and supervise the construction and maintenance of, or enlarging and remodeling of, any and all structures required to provide for the safe disposal of sewage in the sanitary sewer district, as amended.

PROPOSED EXPANSION TO THE LONG NECK SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT TO INCLUDE THE LANDS OF HELENE G. AND LOUIS W. BURTON

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sussex County Council voted on August 23, 2005, to consider extending the Long Neck Sanitary Sewer District (LNSSD) to include parcels of land at the intersection of County Roads 298 and 299, being in Indian River Hundred, Sussex County, Delaware. The parcels are comprised of lots 55, 56, and part of lot 80 of the Elisha A. Steele Subdivision.

This action is in conformity with 9 Del.C. §6502.

A description of the area, which is contiguous to and to be added to the LNSSD is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a concrete monument situate along the northerly right of way of County Road 299 at a point marking a common boundary between the herein described lands and the adjoining Lot 54 of the Elisha A. Steele Subdivision, thence by and with the common boundary of Lot 54 North 18 degrees 01 minutes 45 seconds East by and with the boundary of Lot 79 in the Elisha A. Steele Subdivision a distance of 221.15 feet to an iron pipe, said iron pipe also being on the boundary of the LNSSD; thence with said boundary South 41 degrees 55 minutes 15 seconds East 217.80 feet to an iron pipe set along the Northwesterly right of way of County Road 298; thence following said right of way and continuing with the boundary of the LNSSD, South 49 degrees 35 minutes 00 seconds West 130.95 feet to an iron pipe situated at the intersection of County Road 299; thence leaving the boundary of the LNSSD and continuing with the right of way of Road 299 North 72 degrees 12 minutes 25 seconds West 120 feet to the point of beginning.

The proposed expansion of the LNSSD is within these boundaries and said to contain 0.63 acres, more or less. The boundary description has been prepared using Sussex County Tax Map Number 2-34-23.00, a deed recorded with the Sussex County Recorder of Deeds Office on October 31, 1988 and found in Deed Book 1607 on Page 213, and Sussex County property assessment records.

A map outlining and describing the extension to the LNSSD is attached. The area involved is crosshatched.

The public hearing will be held on this issue at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, November 8, 2005 in the Sussex County Council Chambers, County Administrative Offices, 2 The Circle, Georgetown, Delaware. All interested persons, officials, residents, voters, taxpayers, property owners, or corporations in any way affected by this boundary extension are welcome to attend. There will be an opportunity for questions and answers. The final decision on the boundary extension will be made by the Sussex County Council following the hearing, at one of their regularly scheduled meetings.
