## RESOLUTION NO. R 022 72

WHEREAS, the eligible voters of the proposed Fenwick Island Water and Sanitary Sewer District approved the creation of the water district by a vote of 583 to 94 and the water district by a vote of 566 to 82; and

WHEREAS, Title 9, Delaware Code, Section 6507, requires the County Council to issue a determination of the water and sanitary sewer district within 30 days of its approval by the eligible voters;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Sussex County,
Delaware, hereby determines that the eligible voters of the
Fenwick Island Water and Sanitary Sewer District have approved
the creation of such district; that the description of the
Fenwick Island Water and Sanitary Sewer District is as follows:

That area bounded on the north by Dickson Creek,
Little Assawoman Bay and a line crossing Delaware Route 14, 3.10
miles north of Maryland-Delaware Line; bounded on the east by
the Atlantic Ocean; bounded on the south by the Maryland-Delaware
Line and; bounded on the west by Assawoman Bay, Roy Creek, and
a north-south line extending from Roy Creek to Dickson Creek,
crossing Delaware Route 54, 0.60 miles west of the intersection
of Delaware Route 54 and State Road 58B;
and that the said district is hereby declared to be validly
constituted under the provisions of Title 9, Chapter 65 of the
Delaware Code.
