

RESOLUTION NO. R 022 88

DISTRICT BOUNDARIES FOR THE PROPOSED JOHNSON'S CORNER SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, petitions were received in December, 1987 from fifty-six (56) legal voters of the proposed Johnson's Corner Sanitary Sewer District requesting the Sussex County Council to submit the question of organizing a sanitary sewer district to a vote of electors residing in that area; a map of the proposed district boundaries is attached as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on August 27, 1988 on the question of organizing a sanitary sewer district dealing with the location of the boundaries of the proposed Johnson's Corner Sanitary Sewer District as shown in Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, numerous concerns were voiced concerning the need for central sanitary sewer service outside the proposed boundaries; and


WHEREAS, the proposed Johnson's Corner Sanitary Sewer District was not within the original planning area designated in the Environmental Impact Statement, dated December 1972, for the Bethany Beach Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant, currently known as the South Coastal Regional Wastewater Facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Sussex County Council that it is in the public interest to postpone the establishment of the Proposed Johnson's Corner Sanitary Sewer District until further planning studies are completed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the effective date of this Resolution shall be September 13, 1988.
