

RESOLUTION NO. R 024 72

WHEREAS, the present regulation of the Division of Highways requires streets within new and existing residential developments to be built to standards which are far greater than necessary, which often exceed the standards of the state roads they join, and which are prohibitive to builders of low and moderate income developments; and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Sussex County feels that such developments are preferable to residential growth on individual lots along existing state roads which avoid suburban street regulation,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Sussex County hereby requests that the Division of Highways reduce the paving requirements for streets within suburban developments to permit the use of "tar and chip" on such streets and on the entrances of such streets onto adjoining state roads.
