ADOPTING THE EPA 201 WASTEWATER FACILITIES PLAN FOR THE DAGSBORO-FRANKFORD SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT AS PROPOSED BY GEORGE, MILES AND BUHR.

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council established the Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District by Resolution Number R 019 88 on August 30, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the eligible voters of the Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District approved the creation of the sewer district in an election held on September 17, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council entered into an agreement with George, Miles and Buhr on September 27, 1988, to prepare the EPA 201 Wastewater Facilities Plan for the Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, George, Miles and Buhr completed the <u>Final Report</u>
Wastewater Facilities Plan for the <u>Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary</u>
Sewer <u>District</u> and recommended the following wastewater collection, conveyance, treatment and disposal facilities as the preferred plan:

- -a central gravity sewer collection and transmission system within the Towns.
- -a transmission system to convey wastewater to the treatment site.
- -an aerated lagoon treatment system at the Delmarva Power site.
- -a woodland spray irrigation land application system at the Delmarva Power site.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sussex County Council on behalf of the Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District adopts the <u>Final</u>

Report Wastewater Facilities Plan for the Dagsboro-Frankford

Sanitary Sewer District dated May, 1989, as proposed.
