A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARY OF THE WEST REHOBOTH EXPANSION OF THE DEWEY BEACH SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT (WRX) TO ENCOMPASS A CERTAIN PIECE, PARCEL, OR TRACT OF LAND KNOWN AS HERITAGE GOLF COURSE, LYING CONTIGUOUS TO THE WRX, SITUATE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF COUNTY ROAD 283 AND BEING IN LEWES-REHOBOTH HUNDRED, SUSSEX COUNTY, DELAWARE

WHEREAS, Sussex County has established the West Rehoboth Expansion of the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer District (WRX); and

WHEREAS, in the best interests of the present district and to enhance the general health and welfare of that portion of Sussex County between the Towns of Lewes and Rehobth Beach, which is contiguous to the WRX, the inclusion of this property will be beneficial; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del.C.</u>, Section 6502 (a), the Sussex County Council may, upon request of the County Engineer, revise the boundary of an established sewer district when 50 or more houses have been connected by posting a public notice in four public places in the district describing the new or revised boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council has caused to be posted a public notice in at least four public places in the district, as verified by the affidavit of Phillip C. Calio, a copy of which affidavit and public notice is attached as Exhibit "A" hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del.C.</u>, Section 6502 (b), the Sussex County Council shall, within thirty days after posting the public notices pass a formal resolution establishing the new boundary of the district;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council hereby revised the boundary of the WRX to encompass Heritage Golf Course, situate on the southerly right-of-way of County Road 283, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the southerly right of way of County Road 283, said point also being the northernmost property corner of lands now or formerly (N/F) of

distance of 25± feet to a point, said point being on the WRX boundary; thence proceeding by and with said boundary in a northeasterly, southeasterly, southwesterly, southeasterly, and southwesterly direction, respectively, a distance of 4260± feet to a concrete monument, said monument also being the westernmost property corner of Maplewood Subdivision, said monument also being the easternmost property corner of other lands N/F of Blanche A. Warrington, thence proceeding by and with said other lands N/F of Blanche A. Warrington north 40 degrees 19 minutes 00 seconds west a distance of 2074.8± feet to a point, said point being the easternmost property corner of previous

Blanche A. Warrington; thence proceeding in a straight line in a northwesterly direction a

lands N/F of Blanche A. Warrington, thence proceeding with said previous lands N/F of

Blanche A. Warrington north 38 degrees 58 minutes 38 seconds west a distance of 217.6

feet to the point of beginning (a map outlining and describing the above area is attached

as Exhibit "B"); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council directs the County Engineer and the Attorney for the County Council to procure the necessary lands and right-of-way by purchase, agreement, or condemnation in accordance with the existing statutes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer is hereby directed to prepare maps, plans, specifications, and estimates, elect contracts for and supervise the construction and maintenance of, or enlarging and remodeling of, any and all structures to provide for the safe disposal of sewage in the sanitary sewer district, as amended.

PROPOSED EXPANSION TO THE WEST REHOBOTH EXPANSION OF THE DEWEY BEACH SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sussex County Council voted on August 3, 1999 to consider extending the West Rehoboth Expansion of the Dewey Beach Sanitary Sewer District (WRX) to include the Heritage Golf Course and adjacent lands, being situate in Lewes-Rehoboth Hundred, Sussex County, Delaware.

This action is in conformity with 9 Del.C. §6502.

A description of the area, which is contiguous to and to be added to the WRX is described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the southerly right of way (ROW) of County Road (C.R.) 283, said point also being the westernmost property corner of lands now or formerly (N/F) of Robert D. Clendaniel; thence proceeding in a straight line in a northwesterly direction a distance of 25± feet to a point, said point being on the WRX boundary; thence proceeding by and with said boundary in a northeasterly, southeasterly, southwesterly, southeasterly, and southwesterly direction, respectively, a distance of 5187± feet to a concrete monument, said monument being the westernmost property corner of Maplewood Subdivision, said monument also being the easternmost property corner of lands N/F of Blanche A. Warrington; thence proceeding by and with said Warrington lands North 40° 19'. 00" West a distance of 2074.80± feet to a point, said point being the southeasternmost property corner of other lands N/F of Blanche A Warrington; thence proceeding in a southwesterly direction a distance of 727± feet with previous said lands N/F of Blanche A. Warrington to a point, said point being the southernmost property corner of lands N/F of Mary Ann Foxwell; thence proceeding in a northwesterly direction a distance of 17± feet to a point, said point being the southeasternmost property corner of lands N/F of Robert D. Clendaniel; thence proceeding by and with said Clendaniel lands in a southwesterly and northwesterly direction, respectively, a distance of 300± feet to the point of beginning.

The proposed expansion of the WRX is within these boundaries. The boundary description has been prepared using Sussex County Tax Map Nos. 3-34-6 and 3-34-12 and a site plan submitted by Environmental Consultants International, dated January 29, 1999.

A map outlining and describing the extension of the WRX is attached. The area involved is crosshatched.

The public hearing will be held on this issue at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 28, 1999 in the Sussex County Council Chambers, County Administrative Offices, 2 The

Circle, Georgetown, Delaware. All interested persons, officials, residents, voters, taxpayers, property owners, or corporations in any way affected by this boundary extension are welcome to attend. There will be an opportunity for questions and answers. The final decision on the boundary extension will be made by the Sussex County Council following the hearing, at one of their regularly scheduled meetings.
