

RESOLUTION NO. R 027 02

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE MODIFICATION OF THE OAK MEADOWS STREETLIGHTING DISTRICT BY THE INSTALLATION OF ADDITIONAL STREETLIGHTING

WHEREAS, Chapter 95 of the Sussex County Code provides for the establishment, maintenance, and modification of a streetlighting district, and Sussex County currently operates the Oak Meadows Streetlighting District; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2000, a letter was received from Oak Meadow Owner's Association requesting the installation of additional streetlighting; and the Sussex County Engineering Department and Conectiv, Inc. presented a final layout and cost estimate for additional streetlighting to the Oak Meadows Owner's Association meeting on June 22, 2002; and on July 11, 2002, a letter was received from the Oak Meadows Owner's Association, requesting Sussex County Engineering Department to amend the layout and cost estimate as voted on by their Association, and then proceed with the request to install additional streetlighting in accordance with Chapter 95 of the Sussex County Code; and

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2002, Sussex County Council approved the estimated annual billing rate for the installation of additional streetlighting of \$63.93 for the first year, and \$32.63 after the first year, for each property having a residential or commercial improvement located within the boundaries of the Oak Meadows Streetlighting District; as well as, the establishment of Tuesday, September 10, 2002, at 10:45 a.m., at the Sussex County Council Chambers in the Sussex County Administrative Office Building, 2 The Circle, Georgetown, Delaware, as the date, time and place for a public hearing to consider the request for the installation of additional streetlighting in the Oak Meadows Streetlighting District; and

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Engineering Department did provide appropriate notice to the property owners within the Oak Meadows Streetlighting District, of the date, time and place of the public hearing, and of the estimated costs and charges for the installation of the additional streetlighting as required by Chapter 95 of the Sussex County Code. A Notice of Public Hearing was sent by mail to all property owners; advertised for two weeks in a local paper; and posted in four places within the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, after consideration of the above and all statements made at the public hearing, the Sussex County Council directs the County Engineer to have the additional streetlighting installed as shown on the Final Layout dated September 10, 2002.
