

RESOLUTION NO. R 027 80

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE OAK MEADOWS STREET LIGHTING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the eligible voters of the proposed Oak Meadows Street Lighting District approved the creation of the Light District by a vote of 17 in favor to 15 against the District, in an election held on June 14, 1980; and

WHEREAS, Sussex County Ordinance No. 15 requires the County Council to issue a determination establishing the District in the form of a Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Council of Sussex County, Delaware hereby determines that the eligible voters of the Oak Meadows Street Lighting District have approved the creation of said District that the description of the Oak Meadows Street Lighting District includes property beginning at a concrete monument on the southwesterly right-of-way line of Delaware Route No. 5, 2669.92 feet, more or less, from the intersection of said right-of-way line and Delaware Route No. 24, and being a corner for these lands and lands now or formerly of J. Phillips; thence and with said lands of J. Phillips, South $47^{\circ} 28' 08''$ West, 1354.74 feet to a concrete monument, being a corner for these lands and lands now or formerly of L. L. Harmon; thence and with said land of Harmon, North $43^{\circ} 24' 00''$ West, 1444.64 feet to a point; thence North $46^{\circ} 24' 00''$ East, 1354.50 feet to a point on the southwesterly right-of-way line of said Delaware Route No. 5 and being approximately 1200 feet from its intersection with the right-of-way line of Delaware Route No. 24; thence and with said right-of-way line of Delaware Route No. 5, South $43^{\circ} 36' 00''$ East, 1469.92 feet to the place of beginning, said to contain 45.314 acres, be the same more or less; that said District is hereby declared to be validly constituted under the provisions of Sussex County Ordinance No. 15; that the Public Works Engineer is

authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Delmarva Power and Light Company for installing, maintaining and providing power to the required lighting fixtures in the District; and that the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to bill the owners of all assessable structures within said District in accordance with Sussex County Ordinance No. 15.
