

RESOLUTION NO. R 027 94

SUPPORTING THE DREDGING OF THE ASSAWOMAN CANAL

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council wishes to endorse programs to enhance recreation activities in Sussex County; and

WHEREAS, the State of Delaware Division of Parks and Recreation has proposed the dredging of the Assawoman Canal; and

WHEREAS, the State of Delaware has been deeded the canal banks of the Assawoman Canal by the Federal government; and

WHEREAS, the State of Delaware Division of Parks and Recreation has proposed a program to allow small recreational boating on the Assawoman Canal; and

WHEREAS, the State of Delaware Division of Parks and Recreation has proposed a nature walk on the banks of the Assawoman Canal; and

WHEREAS, the Assawoman Canal is a man-made channel that needs perpetual care; and

WHEREAS, the dredging of the Assawoman Canal may be an environmental benefit to allow for the flushing of the canal;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council, having met in public session, wishes to endorse the State of Delaware's dredging project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution will be presented to Christophe A. G. Tulou, Secretary of the Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control.
