

RESOLUTION NO. R 034 74

RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN OFFICIAL FLAG FOR SUSSEX COUNTY, STATE OF DELAWARE

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Sussex County, this 15th day of October, 1974 that the County Council of Sussex County, in open session met, does by these presents adopt the following design as the official flag of Sussex County, State of Delaware for the Bicentennial Celebration of our County, and more particularly described as follows:

Said flag shall be of the same dimensions as the flag of the State of Delaware and shall consist of Three (3) horizontal bars. The upper bar shall be one-quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the width of said flag and shall be of the color red; the center bar shall be of the color white and shall be one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the width of the said flag; and the lower bar shall be of the color blue and shall be one-quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the width of the flag. Superimposed over the white bar shall be a sheaf of wheat of the color gold and shall appear on both the obverse and reverse sides of said flag.
