A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARY OF THE DAGSBORO-FRANKFORD SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT (DFSSD) TO ENCOMPASS A CERTAIN PIECE, PARCEL, OR TRACT OF LAND OWNED BY HOLLY A. GRAZIER, LYING CONTIGUOUS TO THE DFSSD, SITUATE, LYING, AND BEING IN DAGSBORO HUNDRED, SUSSEX COUNTY, DELAWARE

WHEREAS, Sussex County has established the Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, in the best interests of the present district, and to enhance the general health and welfare of that portion of Sussex County northeast of the Town of Frankford, which is contiguous to the DFSSD, the inclusion of this property will be beneficial; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del.C.</u>, Section 6502(a), the Sussex County Council may, upon request of the County Engineer, revise the boundary of an established sewer district when 50 or more houses have been connected by posting a public notice in four public places in the district describing the new or revised boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council has caused to be posted a public notice in at least four public places in the district, as verified by the affidavit of Chris Calio, a copy of which affidavit and public notice is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del.C.</u>, Section 6502 (b), the Sussex County Council shall, within thirty days after posting the public notice, pass a formal resolution establishing the new boundary of the district;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council hereby revises the boundary of the Dagsboro-Frankford Sanitary Sewer District to encompass a certain piece, parcel, or tract of land owned by Holly A. Grazier, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point where the existing DFSSD boundary crosses the northwest property line of lands now or formerly of Holly A. Grazier, proceeding in a northerly direction  $100\pm$  feet to an iron pipe; thence proceeding in an easterly direction 150 feet

to the centerline of a ditch; thence proceeding by and with said ditch in a southerly direction 50 feet to a curve in the ditch; thence in a southeasterly direction with said ditch a distance of 124 feet; thence following an imaginary straight line in a southwesterly direction 30± feet to the existing DFSSD boundary; thence by and with said DFSSD boundary in a northerly direction to the point of Beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council directs the County Engineer and the Attorney for the County Council to procure the necessary lands and right-of-way by purchase, agreement, or condemnation in accordance with the existing statutes;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer is hereby directed to prepare maps, plans, specifications, and estimates, elect contracts for and supervise the construction and maintenance of, or enlarging and remodeling of, any and all structures required to provide for the safe disposal of sewage in the sanitary sewer district, as amended.


