whereas, pursuant to Delaware Code 9, Section 6503, over 50 eligible voters did sign a petition for Sussex County to submit the question of organizing a Sanitary Sewer District to a referendum for the North Bethany/Cedar Neck area. The proposed boundaries of the North Bethany/Cedar Neck area include all those lands in Baltimore Hundred bounded on the east by the Atlantic Ocean; on the north by the Indian River Inlet; on the west by Indian River Bay, White Creek and the town limits of the Town of Ocean View and; on the south by the northern boundary of the Bethany Beach Sanitary Sewer District. Copies of the petition forms and the proposed planning area map for the North Bethany/Cedar Neck area are attached hereto as Exhibits 1 and 2 respectively; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Delaware Code 9, Section 6504, the Sussex County Council is required to conduct a Public Hearing on the question of organizing a Sanitary Sewer District,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council authorizes William W. Pleasants, P. E., Acting County Engineer, to conduct a Public Hearing on November 16, 1977 for the purpose of hearing any testimony dealing with the location of the boundaries of the proposed North Bethany/Cedar Neck Sanitary Sewer District.
