RESOLUTION NO. R 047 82

WHEREAS, Sussex County has established The Bethany Beach Sanitary Sewer District;

WHEREAS, the sewer district as established includes only the corporate limits of the Town of Bethany Beach;

WHEREAS, in the best interests of the present district, and to enhance the general health and welfare of that portion of Sussex County in Bethany Beach, the inclusion of The Canal Subdivision would be beneficial;

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 Del. C., Section 6502(a), the Sussex County Council may, upon request of the County Engineer, <u>revise the</u> <u>boundaries</u> of an established sewer district when 50 or more houses have been connected by posting a public notice in four public places in the district describing the new or revised boundaries;

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council has caused to be posted a public notice in at least four public places in the district as verified by the affidavit of Robert W. Cerklefskie, a copy of which affidavit and public notice is attached hereto and made a part hereof;

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 Del. C., Section 6502(b) the Sussex County Council shall, within thirty (30) days after posting the public notices pass a formal resolution establishing the new boundaries of the district,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED the Sussex County Council hereby revises the boundary of Bethany Beach Sanitary Sewer District to encompass the corporate limits of the Town of Bethany Beach by adding the area annexed in 1981, known as the Canal development and bounded as follows:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being situate in Baltimore Hundred, Sussex County, State of Delaware and being more fully described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point being a corner of these lands and lands of the Army National Guard Camp; thence by and with line of lands of said Army National Guard Camp (1) S 87°20'10" W, 597.18' to a concrete marker being a point on line; thence continuing with the same bearing,

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a distance of 776.21' (in all making a total distance of 1,373.39') to a concrete marker, said concrete marker being situate on the bank of the Bethany Beach Canal and being a corner of these lands and lands of said Army National Guard Camp; thence leaving lands of said Army National Guard Camp and by with said Bethany Beach Canal (2) S 40°23'43" E, 745.20' to a point situate in the centerline of the Extension of Ocean View Parkway, said point being situate on the said Bethany Beach Canal and being a corner of these lands and lands of Sea Side Village, Inc. and Raymond and Sally Hickman; thence leaving said Bethany Beach Canal and by and with the centerline of the Extension of Ocean View Parkway and line of lands of Sea Side Village, Inc. and Raymond and Sally Hickman (3) S 88°00'00" E, 716.51' to a point, said point being situate in the centerline of the Extension of Ocean View Parkway, being a corner of these lands, other lands of John E. Gibson/Victor G. Trapasso Limited Partnership and a point on line of lands of aforementioned Sea Side Village, Inc. and Raymond and Sally Hickman, said point also being a point of the existing Town Limit Line of Bethany Beach; thence leaving the centerline of the Extension of Ocean View Parkway and lands of Sea Side Village, Inc. and Raymond and Sally Hickman and by and with other lands of John E. Gibson/Victor G. Trapasso Limited Partnership and with the existing Town Limit Line of Bethany Beach (4) N 17°05'45" E, 601.76' to a point, said point being a corner of these lands and other lands of John E. Gibson/Victor G. Trapasso Limited Partnership and being situate on the westerly right-of-way of Route 1; thence leaving said westerly right-of-way of Route 1 (5) N 02°49'23" W, 81.3' to the point of beginning.

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
NOTICE
