RESOLUTION NO. R 053 83

WHEREAS, Sussex County has established the Fenwick Island Sanitary Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, the sewer district, as established, includes lands described as follows:

Bounded on the north by Dirickson Creek, Little Assawoman Bay, in a line crossing Delaware Route 1, 3.10 miles north of the Maryland-Delaware line; bounded on the east by the Atlantic Ocean; bounded on the south by the Maryland-Delaware line; and bounded on the west by the Assawoman Bay, Roy Creek, a lagoon on the westerly boundary of Keen-Wik West, Delaware Route 54, and a north-south line extending from Route 54 to Dirickson Creek beginning at a point 0.60 miles west of the intersection of Delaware Route 58B and Delaware Route 54; and

WHEREAS, in the best interest of the present district, and to enhance the general health and welfare of that portion of Sussex County to the West and South of the existing district, the inclusion of the subdivision to be known as Keen-Wik Sound, as such property is more particularly described below, would be beneficial; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del. C.</u> § 6502, the Sussex County Council may, upon request of the County Engineer, revise the boundaries of an established sewer district when 50 or more houses have been connected to the existing district after posting a public notice in four public places in the district describing the new or revised boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Council has caused to be posted a public notice in at least four public places in the district as verified by the Affidavit of Robert W. Cerklefskie, a copy of which Affidavit and public notice is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 9 <u>Del. C.</u> \$6502(b), Sussex County shall, within 30 days after posting the public notice, pass a form of resolution establishing the boundaries of a new district,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council hereby revises the boundaries of the Fenwick Island Sanitary Sewer District beyond its existing boundaries by adding the property more fully described in Exhibit "B" hereto, which Exhibit "B" is incorporated herein by reference, and that the boundaries of the new district as revised are set forth in Exhibit "C" attached hereto, which Exhibit "C" is incorporated herein by reference; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the revision as proposed is economically feasible and conducive to preservation of the public health; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council directs the County Engineer and the Attorney for the County Council to procure the necessary lands and right-of-way by purchase, agreement or condemnation in accordance with the existing statutes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer is hereby directed to prepare maps, plans, specifications and estimates, elect contracts for and supervise the construction and maintenance of, or enlarging and remodeling of, any and all structures required to provide for the safe disposal of sewage in the sanitary sewer district, as amended; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Sussex County Council directs that the County Engineer, with the assistance of the Attorney for the County Council, submit for execution by Sussex County Council a specific contract with the developer requiring that the developer escrow a sum of \$50,000 to be applied to a payment of an impact fee for eventual improvements to the existing wastewater treatment plant serving the Fenwick Island Sanitary District, which may be necessary to defray the cost of expanding the plant to increase said plant's capacity to adequately discharge any additional waste that may be generated by the subdivision to which this extension applies beyond the current capacity of the sewer plant to adequately and safely treat such sewage waste, if such an impact fee is uniformly imposed by the County Council as a condition of extensions of the existing South Bethany, Bethany Beach and Fenwick Island sewer districts; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the relationship between Act Corporation and Yellow Banks Company and Sussex County in reference to the construction of the sewage facilities to serve its lands is to be itemized in a contract between Act Corporation and Yellow Banks Company and the Sussex County Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no work can be performed before the execution of said contract, which written contract shall specify the manner in which the monies shall be escrowed for payment by the developer of an impact fee, if one is established or the return of said escrowed monies in the event an impact fee is not established for expansion of the existing wastewater treatment plant.

The area includes 96± acres and has been approved as an RPC zone by the Sussex County Council, designated as CZ No. 522. 
