WHEREAS, Captain James R. Whaley, as a member of the Fraternal Order of Police, has served two terms as National Guard, two terms as National Conductor, six years on the Legal Aid Committee, and two years on the Ways and Means Committee; and

WHEREAS, Captain James R. Whaley has, now, been elected to the office of National Treasurer of the Fraternal Order of Police,
