BE IT RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council wants to join in the recognition of this nation's Heroic Fallen Firefighters and their families on this occasion; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council herewith proclaims Sunday, October 14, 1984, as Fallen Firefighters Recognition Day in Sussex County, Delaware; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sussex County Council herewith directs its Director of the Department of Emergency Preparedness to fly the Sussex County Flag at half-mast at the Sussex County Emergency Operations Center, as a Sussex County Tribute to all Fallen Firefighters, on Sunday, October 14, 1984, between dawn and dusk; and
